- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
- 2 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017; to adopt the Counterfeit
- 3 Airbag Prevention Act; to provide penalties and eliminate a current
- 4 penalty; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original section;
- 5 and to outright repeal section 28-635, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 6 Nebraska.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is

- 3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1357 and 28-1601 to 28-1603 <u>and</u>
- 4 sections 2 to 5 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 5 Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 6 Sec. 2. This act shall be known and may be cited as the Counterfeit
- 7 Airbag Prevention Act.
- 8 Sec. 3. For purposes of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act,
- 9 <u>unless the context otherwise requires:</u>
- 10 <u>(1) Airbag means a motor vehicle inflatable occupant restraint</u>
- 11 system device that is part of a supplemental restraint system;
- 12 (2) Counterfeit supplemental restraint system component means a
- 13 replacement supplemental restraint system component, including, but not
- 14 <u>limited to, an airbag that displays a mark identical or substantially</u>
- 15 <u>similar to the genuine mark of a motor vehicle manufacturer or a supplier</u>
- 16 of parts to the manufacturer of a motor vehicle without authorization
- 17 from that manufacturer or supplier, respectively;
- 18 <u>(3) Nonfunctional airbag means a replacement airbag that meets any</u>
- 19 <u>of the following criteria:</u>
- 20 (a) The airbag was previously deployed or damaged;
- 21 (b) The airbag has an electric fault that is detected by the motor
- 22 vehicle's diagnostic system when the installation procedure is completed
- 23 and the motor vehicle is returned to the customer who requested the work
- 24 to be performed or when ownership is intended to be transferred;
- 25 (c) The airbag includes a part or object, including, but not limited
- 26 <u>to, a supplemental restraint system component installed in a motor</u>
- 27 <u>vehicle to mislead the owner or operator of the motor vehicle into</u>
- 28 believing that a functional airbag has been installed; or
- 29 <u>(d) The airbag is subject to the prohibitions of subsection (j) of</u>
- 30 49 U.S.C. 30120; and
- 31 (4) Supplemental restraint system means an inflatable restraint

- 1 system as defined in 49 C.F.R. 571.208, designed for use in conjunction
- 2 <u>with an active safety system. A supplemental restraint system includes</u>
- 3 one or more airbags and all components required to ensure that an airbag
- 4 works as designed by the motor vehicle manufacturer, including both of
- 5 the following:
- 6 (a) The airbag operates as necessary in the event of a crash; and
- 7 (b) The airbag is designed in accordance with federal motor vehicle
- 8 safety standards for the specific make, model, and year of the motor
- 9 <u>vehicle in which it is or will be installed.</u>
- 10 Sec. 4. A person violates the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act if
- 11 <u>the person does any of the following:</u>
- 12 <u>(1) Knowingly and intentionally manufactures, imports, installs,</u>
- 13 <u>reinstalls, distributes, sells, or offers for sale any device intended to</u>
- 14 replace a supplemental restraint system component in any motor vehicle if
- 15 the device is a counterfeit supplemental restraint system component, a
- 16 <u>nonfunctional airbag, or does not meet federal safety requirements as</u>
- 17 provided in 49 C.F.R. 571.208;
- 18 (2) Knowingly and intentionally sells, installs, or reinstalls in a
- 19 motor vehicle a device that causes the motor vehicle's diagnostic system
- 20 to fail to warn when the motor vehicle is equipped with a counterfeit
- 21 <u>supplemental restraint system component, nonfunctional airbag, or no</u>
- 22 airbag is installed.
- 23 (3) Knowingly and intentionally represents to another person that a
- 24 counterfeit supplemental restraint system component or nonfunctional
- 25 airbag installed in a motor vehicle is not a counterfeit supplemental
- 26 <u>restraint system component or a nonfunctional airbag; or</u>
- 27 <u>(4) Causes another person to violate this section or assists another</u>
- 28 person in violating this section.
- 29 Sec. 5. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
- 30 violation of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act is a Class IV felony.
- 31 (2) A violation of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act is a Class

1 IIIA felony if the defendant has been previously convicted of a violation

- 2 of the act.
- 3 (3) A violation of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act is a Class
- 4 III felony if the violation resulted in an individual suffering bodily
- 5 <u>injury</u>.
- 6 (4) A violation of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act is a Class
- 7 IIA felony if the violation resulted in an individual suffering serious
- 8 <u>bodily injury.</u>
- 9 (5) A violation of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act is a Class
- 10 II felony if the violation resulted in the death of an individual.
- 11 Sec. 6. Original section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017,
- 12 is repealed.
- Sec. 7. The following section is outright repealed: Section 28-635,
