- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to state findings; and to
- 2 state intent relating to appropriations to local public health
- departments with respect to preventive health programs.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. The Legislature finds that by focusing on preventive
- 2 <u>health and medicine the state will decrease the amount of serious health</u>
- 3 complications and disease among its residents. By improving health and
- 4 promoting wellness in the areas of preventive health, rather than waiting
- 5 for serious illness or disease to strike, it will save money and lead to
- 6 a healthier state as a whole.
- 7 Sec. 2. <u>It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate to the</u>
- 8 Department of Health and Human Services, for Program No. 502, for
- 9 FY2018-19 \$900,000 General Funds for state aid, for the eighteen local
- 10 <u>public health departments. The Department of Health and Human Services</u>
- 11 <u>shall distribute \$50,000 to each of the local public health departments</u>
- 12 <u>for the purpose of improving preventive health and promoting worksite</u>
- wellness. The preventive health programs that will benefit from the funds
- 14 shall be designed to: Increase physical activity; prevent complications
- 15 from diabetes, cardiovascular disease, and other chronic diseases;
- 16 improve access to medical homes and dental homes to offer prevention and
- 17 wellness services; increase worksite wellness initiatives to prevent
- 18 disease and disability; assure preventive services for children and
- 19 adults; and promote preventive health and wellness in additional ways.
