## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 807**

Committee: Government, Military and Veterans Affairs

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to state government; to state findings; to
- 2 provide for replacement of a statue in the National Statuary Hall of
- 3 the United States Capitol as prescribed; to create a committee; and
- 4 to provide duties.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. The Legislature finds and declares:
- 2 (1) In 1864, the United States Congress established the National
- 3 Statuary Hall Collection in the Old Hall of the House of Representatives
- 4 in the United States Capitol and authorized each state to contribute to
- 5 the hall collection two statues that represent important historical
- 6 figures of each state;
- 7 (2) Nebraska currently has on display in the National Statuary Hall
- 8 <u>Collection statues of William Jennings Bryan and Julius Sterling Morton</u>
- 9 given by the State of Nebraska in 1937;
- 10 (3) In 2000, the United States Congress enacted legislation
- 11 <u>authorizing states to request that the Joint Committee on the Library of</u>
- 12 <u>Congress approve the replacement of a statue the state had provided for</u>
- 13 <u>display in the hall collection;</u>
- 14 (4) Willa Cather is a significant historical and literary figure
- 15 from Red Cloud, Nebraska;
- 16 (5) Willa Cather immortalized Nebraska in such works as My Antonia
- 17 and Oh Pioneers!;
- 18 (6) Willa Cather won the 1923 Pulitzer Prize for her novel One of
- 19 Ours; and
- 20 <u>(7) Willa Cather is worthy of recognition in the National Statuary</u>
- 21 Hall.
- Sec. 2. The Secretary of State shall submit to the United States
- 23 Architect of the Capitol for his or her review for completeness a written
- 24 request to approve the replacement of the statue of Julius Sterling
- 25 Morton currently on display in the National Statuary Hall Collection in
- 26 <u>the United States Capitol with a statue of Willa Cather. The written</u>
- 27 <u>request shall request authorization to provide a new statue, a</u>
- 28 description of the location in Nebraska where the replaced statue will be
- 29 <u>displayed after it is transferred, and a copy of the Nebraska statute</u>
- 30 authorizing such replacement. After such review, it is the intent of the
- 31 Legislature that the architect forward the request to the Joint Committee

- 1 on the Library of Congress for its approval or denial. If the request is
- 2 approved by the committee, the architect and the Director of
- 3 Administrative Services acting on behalf of the State of Nebraska shall
- 4 enter into an agreement as provided in 2 U.S.C. 2132(b).
- 5 Sec. 3. (1) The National Statuary Hall Selection Committee is
- 6 created. The committee shall consist of members of the Nebraska Hall of
- 7 Fame Commission created pursuant to section 72-724.
- 8 (2) Upon approval by the Joint Committee of the Library of Congress
- 9 and pursuant to the agreement described in section 2 of this act, the
- 10 National Statuary Hall Selection Committee shall:
- 11 (a) Select a sculptor to create a statue of Willa Cather to be
- 12 placed in the National Statuary Hall and review and approve the plans for
- 13 the statue; and
- (b) Identify a method to obtain necessary funding to pay for all of
- 15 the following:
- 16 (i) The sculptor for designing and carving or casting the statue;
- 17 (ii) The design and fabrication of the pedestal;
- 18 (iii) The transportation of the statue and pedestal to the United
- 19 States Capitol;
- 20 (iv) The removal and transportation of the replaced statue;
- (v) The temporary placement of the new statue in the Rotunda of the
- 22 United States Capitol for the unveiling ceremony;
- 23 (vi) The unveiling ceremony; and
- 24 (vii) Any other expenses that the committee determines are necessary
- 25 to incur.
