- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Psychology Practice Act; to amend
- 2 sections 38-3101 and 38-3129, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
- 3 to prohibit discrimination in the provision of psychological
- 4 services as prescribed; to provide a duty for the Department of
- 5 Health and Human Services; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal
- 6 the original sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 38-3101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
2 amended to read:

3 38-3101 Sections 38-3101 to 38-3132 and section 3 of this act shall
4 be known and may be cited as the Psychology Practice Act.

5 Sec. 2. Section 38-3129, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
6 amended to read:

7 38-3129 A psychologist and anyone under his or her supervision shall
8 conduct his or her professional activities in conformity with the code of
9 conduct and, pursuant to the code of conduct, not discriminate against a
10 client or patient or a prospective client or patient on the basis of age,
11 gender, gender identity, race, ethnicity, culture, national origin,
12 religion, sexual orientation, disability, or socioeconomic status.

13 Sec. 3. The Department of Health and Human Services shall not adopt
14 and promulgate any rules and regulations or approve, implement, or
15 enforce any policies, practices, or protocols which contradict,
16 contravene, negate, or violate the code of conduct.

17 Sec. 4. Original sections 38-3101 and 38-3129, Reissue Revised
18 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
