- 3 eighteen years of age and older to consent to mental health services
- 4 as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 43-2101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 43-2101 All persons under nineteen years of age are declared to be
- 4 minors, but in case any person marries under the age of nineteen years,
- 5 his or her minority ends. Upon becoming the age of majority, a person is
- 6 considered an adult and acquires all rights and responsibilities granted
- 7 or imposed by statute or common law, except that a person (1) eighteen
- 8 years of age or older and who is not a ward of the state may enter into a
- 9 binding contract or lease of whatever kind or nature and shall be legally
- 10 responsible therefor and (2) eighteen years of age or older may consent
- 11 <u>to mental health services for himself or herself without the consent of</u>
- 12 <u>his or her parent or guardian</u>.
