1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2018, the following 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

6 To amend Article I, section 22:

I-22 (1) All elections shall be free; and there shall be no
hindrance or impediment to the right of a qualified voter to exercise the
elective franchise.

10 (2) In order to protect the fundamental constitutional right of each
 11 eligible citizen to vote, requiring a voter to present identification
 12 prior to being able to vote shall be prohibited.

Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

A constitutional amendment to prohibit requiring presentation of
 identification prior to voting.
