The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The intent of LB 1069 is to change provisions relating to the committee on Americanism as found in sections 79-724 and 79-727, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska. LB 1069 requires that the committee on Americanism hold no fewer than three public meetings annually, keep minutes of all meetings, and ensure social studies curriculum adequately stresses American values that give students the opportunity to become competent, responsible, patriotic, and civil citizens. It also requires the State Board of Education to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the provisions made in the bill while removing a provision that states anyone who violates the law is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor.
