The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB114 is a bill for an act relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road to change provisions relating to motor vehicle lighting requirements, with the intent to harmonize provisions and to repeal the original sections. (Sections 60-6,220, 60-6,221, and 60-6,222, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 60-6,219, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016)

The bill would clarify and amend the requirements for motor vehicle headlight and taillight use, to include that headlights shall be turned on when the motor vehicle's windshield wipers are in continuous or intermittent use due to precipitation or atmospheric moisture, including, but not limited to, rain, snow, sleet, or mist.
