### **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 263 is proposed legislation that that continues the process of amending statutes related to the administration of laws governing the issuance of vehicle titles and registrations by county treasures and the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles. The Department of Motor Vehicles is currently engaged in process to introduce a new Vehicle and Title and Registration computer system and this bill is the latest in a series that modifies law to maximize and enhance the effectiveness and efficiency that the system, when implemented and operational, will bring to the titling and registration process.

The bill introduces a new concept to the vehicle titling and registration process: the implementation of an electronic dealer services system. The system will be voluntary on both the part of the dealer and the dealer's customers. The system would authorize licensed motor vehicle dealers. The system would allow a dealer, when a vehicle is sold, to provide titling and registration services to the purchaser, including the collection of all required fees and taxes.
