The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:
LB 285 makes two changes to Nebraska Public Health statutes. First, it outright repeals section 71-531 that requires an opt-in for HIV tests. Second, it adds a requirement for physicians to add an HIV test to the group of tests that are currently conducted on pregnant women.
