The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 351 would allow the words "Reserve-Veteran" to be placed on the front of operator's licenses or state identification cards of individuals who served in the army, air force, navy, marine or coast guard reserves but were not called to active duty. The words "Guard-Veteran" would be allowed to be placed on the front of operator's licenses or state identification cards of individuals who served in the national guard but were not called to active duty.

The bill would also allow the word "Veteran" to be placed on the front of operator's licenses or state identification cards of individuals who served as members of the officer corps of the U.S. Public Health Service or National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.
