The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB826 reinforces existing state law that grants state court judges the jurisdiction and authority to make factual findings regarding abused, abandoned, and or/neglected children in the context of findings related to the best interest of a child.
