The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative BILL 93 would adopt the Automatic License Plate Reader Privacy Act.

The bill provides criteria for who could use an Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR), and in what situations, provides criteria for the retention and use of data collected from ALPRs, provides criteria for the preservation of ALPR data in certain instances, provides criteria for the publication for policies related to ALPRs, provides reporting requirements, and creates penalties for violation of the act.
