The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB930 makes any statement, admission, or confession made by a juvenile as part of a custodial interrogation admissible only if made in the presence of the juvenile's parent, guardian, or custodian and both were advised of the right to counsel and right to remain silent and both waived these rights before submitting to questioning.

An exception may be made if such statement, admission, or confession would be admissible under the public safety exception to Miranda v. Arizona, 396 U.S. 868 (1969).
