The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LR 266 is a resolution urging the United State Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation and the Nebraska congressional delegation to work together to find a solution that allows people occupying lots around Hugh Butler Lake, Harry Strunk Lake and Swanson Reservoir to freely transfer their permits and leave nonpermanent structures on the lots. It also urges the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission to consider taking such action as may be helpful to bring about a solution that allows for the transfer of permits and for nonpermanent structures to remain on the lots surrounding these lakes.
