## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1001 would create a new section of law.

LB 1001 would, beginning in school year 2021-22, require all newly-issued school identification cards to include any one of the following phone numbers:

- A national suicide prevention hotline

- A local suicide prevention hotline

- A crisis text line

In middle schools or high schools, school boards are responsible for requiring this to take place.

Postsecondary institutions are also required to include the above phone numbers on newly-issued school identification cards.
