Summary of purpose and/or changes:  LB 269 would amend Section 60-1,424 of the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act, and change the allowable use of a school permit. A person who is younger than 16 years and three months but older than 14 years and two months is eligible to operate vehicles with a school permit under certain conditions.  Current law allows permitholders to operate vehicles to and from where he or she attends school, using the most direct route to and from his or her place of residence. LB 269 would expand the allowable destination to include property used by the school he or she attends for purposes of school events or functions.
