## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 396 removes a section of current statute that prohibits continuances in a landlord/tenant court action in most circumstances and if granted requires a deposit of accrued rent.

Section 1 Repeals section 76-1443. This section prohibited continuances in a landlord/tenant court action except for extraordinary cause, and if granted requiring a deposit of rents accrued.
