## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 436 would establish the Complete Count Commission and set out membership qualifications for seventeen commission members and one ex officio member. The Secretary of State would be the chairperson of the commission.

The stated purpose for the commission would be to "develop, recommend, and assist in the administration of a census outreach strategy to encourage full participation in the 2020 federal decennial census."

This work would culminate in an interim report to be submitted to the Legislature by December 1, 2019 and a final report no later than December 31, 2020.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendment, AM 1601, eliminates all original sections. New language would instead grant permissive authority to the Nebraska State Data Center to establish a Complete Count Committee on behalf of the State of Nebraska. The program would be authorized to solicit and spend private funds for committee duties.

The amendment includes the emergency clause, and includes a termination date of January 1, 2021.
