Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 57 would prohibit municipalities from adopting or enforcing ordinances or other regulations that expressly or effectively prohibit the short-term rental of residential properties and restrict the ability of municipalities to regulate residential properties used as short-term rentals.

LB 57 would also provide that the Tax Commissioner could enter into an agreement with an online hosting platform for short-term rentals to permit the online housing platform to collect and remit applicable sales taxes on behalf of sellers or hotel operators otherwise required to collect such taxes for transactions consummated through the online hosting platform.
