Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 699 would amend Section 60-378 relating to transporter certificates and license plates. In lieu of registering each motor vehicle or trailer when a transporter is transporting another vehicle, a transporter may apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles for a transporter's certificate and transporter's license plates. This bill would reduce the time for keeping transporter records of motor vehicles or trailers transported from six years to three years. Those records must be available for inspection by the DMV.
