As amended, LB 1160 is the Nebraska Statewide Workforce and Education Reporting System Act.

Section 2 provides Legislative findings.

Section 3 requires the system to allow Nebraska to:

- Provide workforce outcomes data to postsecondary educational institutions to guide program, educator, and institutional improvement;
- Support students and parents in understanding what education, training, and career pathways best prepare students for occupational success;
- Provide comprehensive data about student success and workforce outcomes to policymakers to inform decisions and resource allocation;
- Track workforce outcomes in order to better align programs with demands in the labor market;
- Disaggregate student outcomes by race, ethnicity, gender, and economic status in order to identify and close educational attainment gaps; and
- Identify the long term return on investment from early education programs.

Section 4 requires the Department of Labor to execute a memorandum of understanding with the Nebraska Statewide Workforce and Education Reporting System before December 31, 2020 to ensure the exchange of available Department of Labor data throughout the prekindergarten to postsecondary education to workforce continuum. The system shall issue a report electronically to the Clerk of the Legislature on or before December 1, 2021. The report shall include recommendations on the planning and development of the Nebraska Statewide Workforce and Education Reporting System, including, but not limited to, additional data and stakeholder needs and potential future funding.

Section 5 is the emergency clause.

The Department of Labor estimates the amended version of LB 1160 will have no fiscal impact.
