- 2 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to change
- 3 judges' salaries; to provide an operative date; to repeal the
- 4 original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 24-201.01 On July 1, 2016, the salary of the Chief Justice and the
- 4 judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred seventy-one thousand
- 5 nine hundred seventy-four dollars and seventy-three cents. On July 1,
- 6 2017, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court
- 7 shall be one hundred seventy-three thousand six hundred ninety-three
- 8 dollars and ninety-seven cents. On January 1, 2019, the salary of the
- 9 Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred
- 10 seventy-six thousand two hundred ninety-nine dollars and thirty-eight
- 11 cents. On July 1, 2019, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of
- 12 <u>the Supreme Court shall be one hundred seventy-nine thousand eight</u>
- 13 hundred twenty-five dollars and thirty-seven cents. On July 1, 2020, the
- 14 salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be
- one hundred eighty-three thousand four hundred twenty-one dollars and
- 16 eighty-eight cents.
- 17 The Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall hold no
- 18 other public office of profit or trust during their terms of office nor
- 19 accept any public appointment or employment under the authority of the
- 20 government of the United States for which they receive compensation for
- 21 their services. Such salaries shall be payable in equal monthly
- 22 installments.
- 23 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2019.
- 24 Sec. 3. Original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 25 Supplement, 2018, is repealed.
- Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 27 passed and approved according to law.
