## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 486**

Introduced by Lowe, 37. Read first time January 22, 2019 Committee: Education

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to education; to adopt the Veteran and Active
- 2 Duty Supportive Postsecondary Institution Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>Sections 1 to 5 of this act shall be known and may be</u>
2	cited as the Veteran and Active Duty Supportive Postsecondary Institution
3	<u>Act.</u>
4	Sec. 2. <u>For purposes of the Veteran and Active Duty Supportive</u>
5	Postsecondary Institution Act:
6	(1) Department means the Department of Veterans' Affairs;
7	(2) Director means the Director of Veterans' Affairs;
8	<u>(3) Military student means a student who serves on active duty in</u>
9	the armed forces of the United States other than active duty for
10	<u>training;</u>
11	(4) Postsecondary institution has the same meaning as in section
12	<u>85-2403; and</u>
13	(5) Veteran student means a student who served on active duty in the
14	armed forces of the United States other than active duty for training.
15	Sec. 3. <u>(1) The department shall establish a process for a</u>
16	postsecondary institution to apply to the director to be designated as
17	Veteran and Active Duty Supportive.
18	<u>(2) To be eligible to be designated as Veteran and Active Duty</u>
19	Supportive, a postsecondary institution shall meet at least five of the
20	following criteria, with respect to its operations in this state:
21	(a) The institution shall have personnel specifically trained and
22	assigned to work with military students and veteran students;
23	<u>(b) The institution shall have a student organization that is</u>
24	dedicated to helping veterans, active duty military, and their families;
25	(c) The institution shall give college credit for certain types of
26	<u>military training;</u>
27	(d) The institution shall have a military leave-of-absence policy;
28	(e) The institution shall have counseling and advising services for
29	military students and veteran students;
30	(f) The institution shall have an accredited Reserve Officer
31	Training Corps program;

1	(g) The institution shall have clearly identifiable on its web site
2	a listing of services provided to military students and veteran students;
3	and
4	(h) The institution shall specially recognize military students and
5	veteran students during graduation or in other ways which are intended to
6	demonstrate the institution's respect for such students' service.
7	<u>(3) The department shall maintain on its web site a list of</u>
8	postsecondary institutions designated as Veteran and Active Duty
9	Supportive pursuant to this section.
10	Sec. 4. <u>A designation as Veteran and Active Duty Supportive under</u>
11	<u>section 3 of this act shall be valid for a term of three years. A</u>
12	postsecondary institution may apply to the director to renew its
13	designation through a process established by the department.
14	Sec. 5. <u>The department may adopt and promulgate rules and</u>
15	regulations necessary to carry out the Veteran and Active Duty Supportive

16 <u>Postsecondary Institution Act.</u>
