- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to postsecondary education; to require a
- 2 sexual assault campus climate survey, a report, and training.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. <u>Once every two years, each public postsecondary</u>
- 2 <u>educational institution shall administer an anonymous sexual assault</u>
- 3 <u>campus climate survey to its students.</u>
- 4 (2) Participation in the survey shall be voluntary. No student shall
- 5 <u>be required to participate in the survey. No student shall face</u>
- 6 retribution or negative consequences of any kind for declining to
- 7 participate.
- 8 (3) Each public postsecondary educational institution shall develop
- 9 a survey and establish procedures for administration of the survey on
- 10 each of its campuses.
- 11 (4) On or before September 1, 2019, and September 1 of each odd-
- 12 numbered year thereafter, each public postsecondary educational
- 13 <u>institution shall electronically submit a report to the Legislature that</u>
- 14 includes the results of the sexual assault campus climate survey and
- 15 <u>contains information about the number of sexual assault complaints made</u>
- 16 to the institution during the two-year reporting period. The report shall
- 17 not include the personal information of victims or perpetrators. Each
- 18 public postsecondary educational institution shall also post the report
- 19 on the web site for each campus of such institution and in any other
- 20 <u>manner or venue the institution deems necessary or appropriate. The</u>
- 21 report shall include information regarding:
- 22 (a) Types of sexual misconduct;
- 23 (b) The outcome of each investigation into sexual misconduct; and
- (c) Disciplinary actions taken by the institution.
- 25 (5) On or before January 1, 2020, each public postsecondary
- 26 educational institution shall develop a program for training for all
- 27 <u>individuals involved in implementing student grievance procedures</u>
- 28 relating to sexual assaults or sexual misconduct policy violations,
- 29 <u>including individuals responsible for resolving complaints and</u>
- 30 interviewing alleged victims. The training program may be developed in
- 31 consultation with state or local victim services organizations. Each

1 <u>public postsecondary educational institution shall ensure that such</u>

2 <u>individuals receive such training beginning no later than the beginning</u>

3 of the 2020-21 school year.
