1 Section 1. Section 43-2101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 43-2101 All persons under nineteen years of age are declared to be
- 4 minors, but in case any person marries under the age of nineteen years,
- 5 his or her minority ends. Upon becoming the age of majority, a person is
- 6 considered an adult and acquires all rights and responsibilities granted
- 7 or imposed by statute or common law, except that a person (1) eighteen
- 8 years of age or older and who is not a ward of the state may (a) acquire
- 9 or convey title to real property or (b) enter into a binding contract or
- 10 lease of whatever kind or nature and shall be legally responsible
- 11 therefor and (2) eighteen years of age or older may consent to mental
- 12 health services for himself or herself without the consent of his or her
- 13 parent or guardian.
