- 3 28-1212.03 (1) Any person who possesses, receives, retains, or
- 4 disposes of a stolen firearm knowing that it has been or believing that
- 5 it has been stolen shall be guilty of a Class IIA felony unless the
- 6 firearm is possessed, received, retained, or disposed of with intent to
- 7 restore it to the owner.
- 8 (2) Any person who possesses, receives, retains, or disposes of a
- 9 <u>stolen firearm when such person should have known, or had reasonable</u>
- 10 cause to believe, that such firearm has been stolen shall be quilty of a
- 11 Class IIA felony unless the firearm is possessed, received, retained, or
- 12 <u>disposed of with intent to restore it to the owner.</u>
