- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public safety; to prohibit peace officers
- from serving or working as school resource officers as prescribed.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this
- 2 <u>section</u>, <u>no peace officer shall serve or work as a school resource</u>
- 3 <u>officer, whether or not such officer is on duty as an employee of a law</u>
- 4 <u>enforcement agency at the time of such service or work.</u>
- 5 (2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section do not apply to
- 6 a peace officer who is:
- 7 (a) Responding to a specific request for assistance from a student,
- 8 <u>school employee</u>, or member of the public regarding a safety threat or a
- 9 <u>criminal act; or</u>
- 10 (b) Providing security for an extracurricular event or activity.
- 11 (3) For purposes of this section:
- 12 <u>(a) Law enforcement agency means an agency or department of this</u>
- 13 <u>state or of any political subdivision of this state that is responsible</u>
- 14 for the prevention and detection of crime, the enforcement of the penal,
- 15 traffic, or highway laws of this state or any political subdivision of
- 16 this state, and the enforcement of arrest warrants. Law enforcement
- 17 agency includes a police department, an office of a town marshal, an
- 18 office of a county sheriff, the Nebraska State Patrol, and any department
- 19 to which a deputy state sheriff is assigned as provided in section
- 20 <u>84-106; and</u>
- 21 (b) Peace officer means any officer or employee of a law enforcement
- 22 agency authorized by law to make arrests.
