- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Registration Act; to 1 2 amend section 60-3,102, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and 3 sections 60-3,122, 60-3,122.02, 60-3,122.04, 60-3,123, 60-3,124, and 4 60-3,125, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to change 5 provisions relating to fees for Pearl Harbor plates, Gold Star 6 Family plates, Military Honor plates, prisoner-of-war plates, 7 disabled veteran plates, and Purple Heart plates; and to repeal the original sections. 8
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-3,102, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

(5) If the cost of manufacturing Military Honor Plates at any time exceeds the amount charged for license plates pursuant to section 60-3,102, any money to be credited to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund shall instead be credited first to the Highway
