1 Section 1. Section 30-2201, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 30-2201 Sections 30-401 to 30-406, 30-701 to 30-713, 30-2201 to
- 4 30-2902, 30-3901 to 30-3923, 30-4001 to 30-4045, and 30-4201 to 30-4210,
- 5 <u>sections 2 to 4 of this act,</u> and the Public Guardianship Act shall be
- 6 known and may be cited as the Nebraska Probate Code.
- 7 Sec. 2. <u>An individual who is related to the decedent through two</u>
- 8 <u>lines of relationship is entitled to only a single share based on the</u>
- 9 relationship that would entitle the individual to the larger share.
- 10 Sec. 3. (a) A parent is barred from inheriting from or through a
- 11 <u>child of the parent if the parent's parental rights were terminated and</u>
- 12 the parent-child relationship was not judicially reestablished.
- 13 (b) For the purpose of intestate succession from or through the
- 14 deceased child, a parent who is barred from inheriting under this section
- is treated as if the parent predeceased the child.
- 16 Sec. 4. A will may provide for the passage of all property the
- 17 <u>testator owns at death and all property acquired by the estate after the</u>
- 18 testator's death.
- 19 Sec. 5. Original section 30-2201, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 20 Supplement, 2018, is repealed.
