## **LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 11CA**

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2020, the following 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

To amend Article III, section 8:

7 III-8 No person shall be eligible to the office of member of the Legislature unless on the date of the general election at which he or she 8 9 is elected, or on the date of his <u>or her</u> appointment, the person he is a registered voter, has attained the age of <u>nineteen</u> twenty-one years, and 10 has resided within the district from which he is elected for the term of 11 one year next before his or her election, unless the person has he shall 12 have been absent on the public business of the United States or of this 13 State. No And no person elected as a member of the Legislature aforesaid 14 shall hold <u>such</u> his office after he <u>or she</u> shall have removed from such 15 16 district.

17 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors 18 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI, 19 section 1, with the following ballot language:

A constitutional amendment to change the age of eligibility for the office of member of the Legislature to nineteen years of age.
