The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB240 allows a judge to commit a defendant who is incompetent to stand trial to the Department of Health and Human Services for treatment at a facility other than one that is state-owned and operated. This includes a private facility, a facility (other than a jail) operated by a political subdivision, or on an outpatient basis at these facilities. A defendant would not be eligible for outpatient treatment if they are charged with an offense for which bail is prohibited or if the public's safety would be at risk.
