The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 270 is proposed legislation that amends, revises, and harmonizes statutory provisions relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles. It amends implementation dates, updates provisions relating to electronic certificates of title for vehicles and motorboats, updates provisions relating to "previously salvaged" titles, amends provisions regarding the types of vehicles that may tow historical trailers, allows certain evidence for issuance of titles to manufactured homes, eliminates federal references, allows the issuance of temporary stickers for persons who apply for specialty plates, amends provisions relating to electronic issuance of operator's licenses and state identification cards, and changes point assessment procedures for drunk driving convictions.
