The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB308 is drafted to address an issue raised in the wake of the Nebraska Court of Appeals opinion in Bayliss v. Clason, 26 Neb. 195, 918 N.W.2d 612 (2018). In Bayliss, the Court of Appeals found that the filing of a suggestion of bankruptcy constitutes a general appearance in a civil matter, resulting in the plaintiff submitting to the jurisdiction of the court. LB308 would provide that such a filing is not a general appearance. LB308 would also adjust statute establishing a deadline for effecting service in the civil matter to account for the impact any potential stay from the filing of a suggestion of bankruptcy may have on the deadline.
