The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:
LB 492 would adopt the Regional Metropolitan Transit Authority Act. Under the Act, a municipality or group of municipalities within a metropolitan statistical area may create a regional metropolitan transit authority (RMTA). The Act also provides a process by which an existing transit authority created under the Transit Authority Law could convert into a RMTA.
Each RMTA created under the Act would be governed by a seven-member elected board.
