## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### LB719

#### Date of Hearing: February 12, 2019

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Currently, scrap recyclers and junk and salvage yards are required to surrender titles for junked motor vehicles to the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles. In addition to this reporting, scrap recyclers and junk and salvage yards are required by federal law to report their full inventory of all junk or salvage motor vehicles obtained in whole or in part to the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS).

LB719 would make Nebraska the first state to allow scrap recyclers and junk and salvage yards to streamline both reports to the DMV who will then report on to NMVTIS. This will eliminate duplicative reporting requirements for scrap recyclers and junk and salvage yards.
