The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB883 makes two changes regarding child support orders. The first change would make any potential obligor or obligee a party in interest to child support or paternity cases. Currently, if a custodial parent receives state assistance and the state is bringing the action against the other parent, the custodial parent may not be a party to the case. This denies them certain legal remedies available to other custodial parents.

The second change requires notice in child support orders explaining the obligee's ability-as a party to the case- to file an Application for Order to Show Cause that requests the court enter an order requiring the person who owes support to appear in court and show cause why they should not be held in contempt of court for failure to pay child support.
