A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend sections 28-115 and 28-310.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to prohibit assault by strangulation or suffocation as prescribed; to provide for an enhanced penalty for assault by strangulation or suffocation of a pregnant woman; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 28-115, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, Section 1. is amended to read:

28-115 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, any person who commits any of the following criminal offenses against a pregnant woman shall be punished by the imposition of the next higher penalty classification than the penalty classification prescribed for the criminal offense:

(a) Assault in the first degree, section 28-308;

(b) Assault in the second degree, section 28-309;

(c) Assault in the third degree, section 28-310; (d) Assault by strangulation or suffocation, section 28-310.01;

<u>(e)</u> (d) Sexual assault in the first degree, section 28-319;

(f) (e) Sexual assault in the second or third degree, section 28-320;

(g) (f) Sexual assault of a child in the first degree, section 28-319.01; (h) (g) Sexual assault of a child in the second or third degree, section 28-320.01;

(i) (h) Sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee in the first degree, section 28-322.02;

(j) (i) Sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee in the second degree, section 28-322.03;

(k) (j) Sexual abuse of a protected individual in the first or second degree, section 28-322.04; (1) (k) Domestic assault in the first, second, or third degree, section

28-323;

(1) Assault on an officer, an emergency responder, (m) а state correctional employee, a Department of Health and Human Services employee, or a health care professional in the first degree, section 28-929;

(n) (m) Assault on an officer, an emergency responder, а state correctional employee, a Department of Health and Human Services employee, or a

health care professional in the second degree, section 28-930; (o) (n) Assault on an officer, an emergency responder, a state correctional employee, a Department of Health and Human Services employee, or a health care professional in the third degree, section 28-931; (p) (o) Assault on an officer, an emergency responder,

state а correctional employee, a Department of Health and Human Services employee, or a health care professional using a motor vehicle, section 28-931.01; (q) (<del>p)</del> Assault by a confined person, section 28-932; (r) (<del>q)</del> Confined person committing offenses against another person,

section 28-933; and

(s) (r) Proximately causing serious bodily injury while operating a motor vehicle, section 60-6,198. (2) The enhancement in subsection (1) of this section does not apply to

any criminal offense listed in subsection (1) of this section does not apply to punishable as a Class I, IA, or IB felony. If any criminal offense listed in subsection (1) of this section is punishable as a Class I misdemeanor, the penalty under this section is a Class IIIA felony.

(3) The prosecution shall allege and prove beyond a reasonable doubt that the victim was pregnant at the time of the offense.

Sec. 2. Section 28-310.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

28-310.01 (1) A person commits the offense of assault by strangulation or suffocation if the person knowingly and intentionally: or

(a) Impedes intentionally impedes the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of another person by applying pressure on the throat or neck of the other person; or -(b) Impedes the normal breathing of another person by covering the mouth

and nose of the person.

(2) An offense is committed under this section regardless of whether a visible injury resulted.

(3) (2) Except as provided in subsection (4) (3) of this section, <u>a</u> violation of this section strangulation is a Class IIIA felony. (4) A violation of this section (3) Strangulation is a Class IIA felony

if (a) The person used or attempted to use a dangerous instrument while

committing the offense;
(b) The person caused serious bodily injury to the other person while

(b) The person caused serious bodily injury to the other person while committing the offense; or (c) The person has been previously convicted of <u>a violation of this</u> <u>section strangulation</u>. <u>(5)</u> (4) It is an affirmative defense that an act constituting strangulation <u>or suffocation</u> was the result of a legitimate medical procedure.
