Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1011, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor, is part of the Governor's 2022 midbiennium budget adjustment recommendations for the 2021-2023 biennium. The bill makes adjustments to appropriations and reappropriations for state operations, aid and construction programs, and modifies intent language and earmarks accompanying appropriations approved by the 107th Legislature, First Session, for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 and the next fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. This legislative bill contains the emergency clause.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment becomes the bill. The amendment contains the Appropriations Committee's recommendation for new and adjustments to existing appropriations and re-appropriations for state operations, aid and construction programs,

provides for certain transfers, and modifies intent language and earmarks accompanying appropriations approved by the 107th Legislature, First Session, for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 and the next fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

Details of the Committee's recommendation may be found in the booklet entitled, "Appropriations Committee Budget Proposal-Mid Biennium Budget Adjustments, FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23" dated March 2022.

The committee amendment includes all, or a portion of, the provisions of the following bills:

LB 788 Change appropriations intent language and matching fund provisions under the Nebraska Rural Projects Act

LB 792 Appropriate funds to the Department of Health and Human Services for the Youth Rehabilitation and Treatment Center-Kearney

LB 813 State intent regarding funding for development and improvements along the national rail-trail route

LB 893 Appropriate funds for provider rate increases for developmental disability services

LB 989 Appropriate funds for medicaid nursing facility rates

LB 1015 Adopt the Perkins County Canal Project Act

LB 1023 Adopt the Lake Development Act and the Water Recreation Enhancement Act

LB 1049 Appropriate funds to the Supreme Court for the Office of Public Guardian

LB 1071 Appropriate funds for the workforce housing grant program

LB 1111 Appropriate funds to the Supreme Court for community corrections

LB 1164 State intent regarding an increase in reimbursement rates for Child Welfare Aid

LB 1197 Appropriate funds to the Department of Correctional Services for grants to mentor justice-involved individuals

LB 1232 Appropriate funds from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Department of Economic Development for a capital construction grant for the United States Strategic Command Nuclear Command, Control, and Communications public-private partnership facility

LB 1233 Rename and change provisions relating to the United States Space Command Headquarters Assistance Fund, change provisions relating to the Cash Reserve Fund, and state legislative intent relating to development at Offutt Air Force Base

LB 1252 Appropriate federal funds to the Department of Economic Development for middle-income housing
