Summary of purpose and/or changes:

A REVISED VERSION OF LB1022 WAS AMENDED INTO LB750. REFER TO THE LB750 COMMITTEE STATEMENT FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

Amends section 60-4,115; Operator's license fees.

The bill amends a provision related to the fee for the 24/7 sobriety permit program.

Under the program an individual pays a permit fee of \$25. Current law provides \$5 of the fee shall be remitted to the county treasurer of the individual's county of residence. The bill changes the disposition of this fee to the county treasurer which issued the permit.
