Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 71-4603; definitions used for purposes of the Uniform Standard Code for Manufactured Homes and Recreational Vehicles.

- 1-The definition of fifth wheel trailer is amended by eliminating language that limits a fifth wheel trailer to no more than 430 square feet in set-up mode;
- 2-The definition of "Park Trailer" is changed to a "Park Model Recreational Vehicle" and is defined to be temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, travel, or seasonal use, not permanently affixed to real estate, built on a single chassis mounted on wheels with a gross trailer area not exceeding 400 square feet, and certified by the manufacturer as complying with the ANSI Park Model Recreational Vehicle Standard.
- 3-The definition of "Travel Trailer" is amended by eliminating language that limits a travel trailer to having a gross trailer area of more than 430 square feet.
