**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB1186, introduced by Senator Bostar, Amends Sections in chapters 58 and 76 to rename the Oil Pipeline Reclamation Act to the Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Reclamation Act, to apply the newly named Act to abandoned pipelines and carbon-dioxide pipeline, to define those terms, to expand the costs for which a carrier is responsible upon decommissioning or abandoning a pipeline under the Act and to add a timeline for notice and post-decommissioning actions.
