**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

A REVISED VERSION OF LB1259 WAS AMENDED INTO LB750. REFER TO THE LB750 COMMITTEE STATEMENT FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

Amends section 60-3,101; issuance of license plates for motor vehicles, fees.

The section is amended to provide that license plates issued beginning in 2023 shall be issued for a period 10 years, rather than 6 years as currently prescribed by law.

The fee charged when new license plates are issued is increased from \$3.50 per plate to \$5.00 per plate beginning January
