Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill repeals locksmith registration requirements in Nebraska. Current law requires a Nebraska locksmith to obtain a registration certificate from the County Clerk in the county in which their business is located. The certificate requires a \$5 fee, name, SSN, brief criminal history and name and address of 3 references. This certificate is valid until the locksmith changes the name or place of business. Failure to comply is a Class IV misdemeanor.
