## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 448 would impose a \$3 surcharge on each operators%u2019 license, permit or state identification card. This surcharge would be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska State Patrol Retirement System. This charge would begin on January 1, 2022.

Section-by-Section Summary

Section 1 would amend section 60-4,115 to add a \$3 fee to operators%u2019 licenses, permits, and state ID cards, with this amount credited to the State Patrol Retirement Fund.

Section 2 would repeal the original section.
