Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 48 amends marriage and annulment statutes by removing a provision that those with a venereal disease shall not marry. The bill also replaces the phrase "under disability" with "who are incapacitated" regarding annulments. The proposal also provides that an annulment action can be filed in a county where either party resides. Current law sets the plaintiff's home county as the venue.
