Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 758 is expanding the Nebraska Farm-to-School Program Act, enacted in 2021 via LB396, to include early childhood education programs. Early childhood education program has the same meaning defined in Neb. Rev. Stat. 79-1101, which includes those affiliated with a public school district or ESU.

Explanation of amendments:

AM1684 adds to the eligible programs already established in the bill those programs as defined in Neb. Rev. Stat. 71-1910, which includes any licensed program under the Quality Childcare Act.
