Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 888 changes the definition of "multicultural education" to add studies relative to the Holocaust and other acts of genocide. "Multicultural education" is currently defined as "includ[ing], but is not limited to, studies relative to the culture, history, and contributions of African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, and Asian Americans."
