The coordinator shall gather data on housing capacity and conditions throughout the state and make recommendations for incentives and policy to the Urban Affairs Committee of the Legislature on or before July 1, 2023 and by July 1 every two years after. All costs would be borne by the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority. NIFA estimates a cost between \$835,500 and \$950,634 No fiscal impact to the state of Nebraska.
