LB 446 would create the Nebraska Housing Index and Financing Investment System Act. This act would create the role of Nebraska Housing Index and Financing Investment System coordinator within the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority. The coordinator shall gather data on housing capacity and conditions throughout the state and make recommendations for incentives and policy to the Urban Affairs Committee of the Legislature on or before July 1, 2023 and by July 1 every two years after. All costs would be borne by the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority. NIFA previously estimated a cost between \$835,500 and \$950,634 No fiscal impact to the state of Nebraska.

NIFA is authorized to charge fees for providing technical assistance, including distribution of data and information concerning the needs of the state, pursuant to 58-239(13). NIFA anticipates monetizing portions of the data to offset program costs.
